System requirements

This Missions Pack does not requires any additional equipment. The product can be used with the same requirements to run Microsoft Flight Simulator.

A running copy of Microsoft Flight Simulator installed on your Pc is required in order to use the product, as well!

However, here is a list of minimum requirements:

- Microsoft Windows 10 with last updates
- Microsoft Flight Simulator (Standard, De Luxe or Premium)
- CD-ROM drive (for boxed version)
- 500 MB of free disk space
- Adobe Acrobat Reader 6 or higher to read and print the manual (1)

Installation

To install the product on your Personal Computer:

- 1) Open the zip archive **DAHERTBM_CH.zip** and put the content into your **Flight Simulator Community Folder**.

Note: You must enter the correct path manually, browsing the folder on your Pc.

That why the Microsoft Flight Simulator's "Community" folder is located in dependance of your own settings and Version installed.

The Path should be something like this below:

For the Windows Store install:

C:\Users\[Your User Name]\AppData\Local\Packages\
Microsoft.FlightSimulator_8wekyb3d8bbwe\LocalCache\Packages\Community

For the Steam install:

C:\Users\[Your User Name]\AppData\Local\Packages\
Microsoft.FlightDashboard_8wekyb3d8bbwe\LocalCache\Packages\Community

NOTE: Windows 10 by default hides the "AppData" folder, so before installing, you will have to go to "View" in the menu of File Explorer, and select show "Hidden items" so as to see it.

Be sure to install into the correct folder!

In this manner all files will be copied into the appropriate subfolder. In brief.

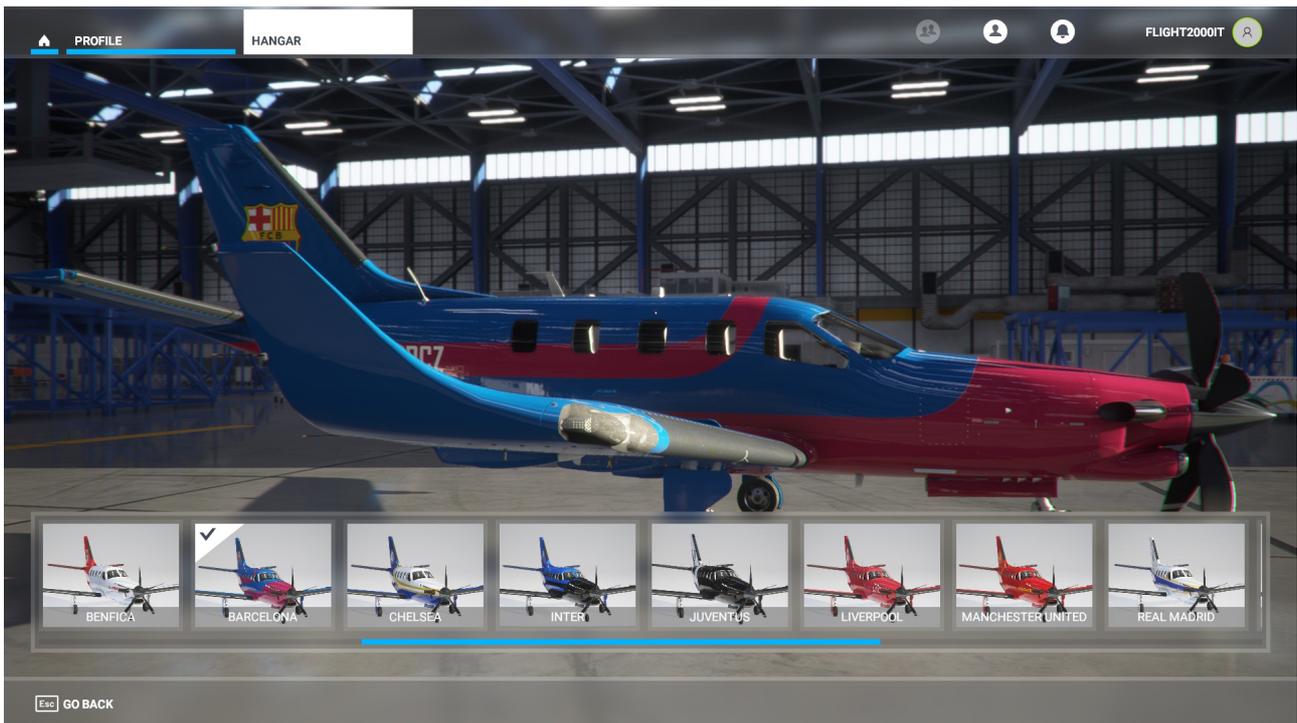

How to select The TBM 930 Champions League Liveries

From the Main Flight Simulator screen, click on **PROFILE** , Then **HANGAR**

Put "**TBM**" in the search bar, the Diamond DA62 will be displayed. Now confirm then click on **LIVERIES** to see all variation.



How To Use Your Own Plane In Missions

Although Microsoft doesn't allow you to change planes during a Bush Trip mission, there is an easy way around this limitation

- 1) Go in **Option/General** menu
- 2) Activate **DEVELOPER MODE**
- 3) A new menu will appear in the upper window
- 4) Click on **Windows** menu item, then on **Aircraft Selector**

Bush Trip – Glory Run

Product include a Bush Trip – Glory Run to replicate the trip of a Bayern Munich fan to attend the Champions League match final, played in Lisbon against Paris St Germain and won by the German team.

You will find **Bush Trip – Glory Run** into the **ACTIVITIES/BUSH TRIP** section.

Into The Cockpit



Routes are already loaded in your G1000 with all point of interest. You can follow the flightplan directly from your PFD. After take-off you can activate the autopilot and press the NAV button.

Also, you can use the toolbar to display the VFR Map for reference about the flight progress.

Since the flights are organized according to the Bush Trips scheme, the route is not displayed on the MFD.

You can also access in any time to the NAVLOG to receive more info about distances, ETE and waypoints.

There are 4 legs to compete the bush trip:

- EDDM to LSGG
- LSGG to LFBO
- LFBO to LEBG
- LEBG to LPPT
