System Requirements for this product:

- Trainsimulator 2014
- ICE 1 Add-On (Steam)
- Hamburg - Hannover (Steam)
- DB BR 424 (Steam)
- European Loco and Asset Pack (Steam)
- ME BR 146 Metronom (Steam)
- DB BR 151 vRot / trafficed (virtualRailroads)
- DB BR 120 vRot / trafficed (virtualRailroads)
- IC Wagen Eurofima Apmz, Bpmz, Wrmz (virtualRailroads)

The listed addons (routes, rollingstock, engines, etc.) are not part of this product and may be purchased seperately.

Installation:

- Double-click the unzipped .exe-file provided with your download.
- Choose your language
- Follow the instructions from the installation program.



Note: The installer tries to install your addon into the default installation position of Trainsimulator 2014 which normally resides in the following folder: „DriveName\Steam\steamApps\common”.

If your Steam installation is not located at *the default place*, you will have to enter the correct path to your „railworks” folder manually.

Examples:

- C:\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks
- E:\Games\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks
- K:\MyGames\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks
- G:\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks

(These examples may not reflect the path used on your specific computer system)

In case the entered path is wrong, the installation will ask for a new folder to be created, in this case click „No” as this indicates that your program will not be installed properly.

Deinstallation:

If you ever need to uninstall your program, you may follow these instruction:

- Click on the Windows Icon in your taskbar
- Choose: All Programs
- Select the Trains and Drivers Folder
- Click on the uninstaller-icon



Playing your new scenarios in Trainsimulator 2013:

When you start Trainsimulator 2014 you will be in the main menu by default. Open the „Drive“ menu, select „Standard“ and then select your desired route and scenario.

Possible errors:

The scenario fails to load and shows an error message saying:

„Can´t load railvehicle XYZ...”

This has something to do with your installed rollingstock. If you don´t match the requirements of the addon and rollingstock is missing, you will see this error message.

In some cases this is just a cache problem which can be solved by clearing the cache of the game:

Mainmenu/Gamesettings/Tools/Clear Cache

„Something bad has happened“

This error seems to have many reasons :-)

But you should do the following to keep you away from this error:

- *Make sure your game and addons are installed properly*
- *Clear the cache if needed*
- *Verify gamefiles via Steam from time to time*
- *Do not try to edit a scenario and try to run it afterwards.*



Scenario listing:

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 1. ICE 1097 Hamburg Altona – Darmstadt Hbf**

It's a very cold morning and you are in charge of ICE 1097, the ICE Sprinter from Hamburg to Darmstadt via Frankfurt. The ICE Sprinter services calls only at the most important stations, so during your shift you will only stop at Hamburg Hbf and Hannover Hbf.

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 2. ICE 74 Zürich HB - Kiel Hbf**

Drive the ICE 74 from Hannover - Hamburg in this autumn afternoon.

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 3. ICE 588 München Hbf - Hamburg Altona**

Drive the Intercity Express 588 from the outskirts of Hannover to Hamburg, stopping at Harburg on the way.

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 4. ICE 585 Lübeck Hbf - München Hbf**

You are coming from Lubeck, via Berliner Tor. Proceed to track 8 and open the doors to let passengers in. During the stop change cabs in preparation to the travel towards Hannover.

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 5. ICE 886 München Hbf - Hamburg Altona**

The ICE 886 is one of the few ICEs stopping at Lüneburg. Drive it from Hannover - Hamburg on this beautiful summer morning.

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 6. IC 2379 Stralsund Hbf - Hannover Hbf**

This train comes from Stralsund and you are driving it until it's final destination, Hannover, where you are scheduled to arrive at 19:57.

- **TaD High Speed 3 - 7. IC 2184 Hannover Hbf - Ostseebad Binz**

It's early morning and the weather is very bad. You are in charge of the Intercity 2184 - Ostseebad Binz, and you will drive it until Hamburg.
