INSTALLATION

- Download your product using the downloadlink provided in your eMail
- Unzip the .zip-file into a place where you can easily access it. We recommend unzipping it to your desktop.
- Double-click the unzipped .exe-file provided with your download.
- Choose your language for the installation. The language setting you use here is not affecting the language settings of the scenarios or Trainsimulator 2014, this selection is only valid for the installation process itself.
- Follow the instructions during the installation program runs.

Note: The installer tries to install your addon into the default installation position of Train-simulator 2014. Trainsimulator 2014 normally resides in the following folder:

„DriveName\Steam\steamApps\common“.

If your Steam installation is not located at the default place, you will have to enter the correct path to your „railworks“ folder manually.

Examples:

- C:\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks
- E:\Games\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks
- K:\MyGames\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks
- G:\Steam\steamApps\common\railworks

(These examples may not reflect the path used on your specific computer system)

In case the entered path is not correct, the installation will ask for a new folder to be created, in this case click „No“ as this indicates that your program will not be installed properly. Enter the correct railworks path instead.

DEINSTALLATION

If you ever need to uninstall your program, follow these instruction:

- Click on the Windows Icon in your taskbar
- Choose: All Programs
- Select the Trains and Drivers folder
- Click on the uninstaller-icon of the product you want to uninstall.

YOUR SCENARIOS IN TRAINSIMULATOR 2014

When you start Trainsimulator 2014, you will see the main menu. Select „DRIVE“ and then „STANDARD“. You can now choose from all routes you have installed. Select the route you want to drive on and on which you have installed Trains and Drivers scenarios.

You will see a list with all scenarios that are available for this route. The Trains and Drivers scenarios are named in this scheme: „TaD – product name – scenario name.“



TROUBLESHOOTING

- The scenario fails to load and shows an error message saying:

„Can´t load railvehicle XYZ...“

This has something to do with your installed rollingstock. If you don´t match the requirements of the addon and rollingstock is missing, you will see this error message.

In some cases this is just a cache problem which can be solved by clearing the cache of the game:

Main menu/Game settings/Tools/Clear Cache



THE SCENARIOS

- **TaD - Airshow Special**
It's the day of the Dalwish Airshow and extra trains are running for the event. Drive Train 2F43 from Paignton to Exeter following Train 2F41 along the coast to pick up the remaining passengers from the Airshow. Then form Train 5F43 and return to Exeter TMD to split your train and stable it for the night.
- **TaD - Last train down the coast**
Drive Train 2T20, the last train to Paignton, and the return back to Exeter St. Davids, Train 2E67. This is a nice quiet run, but watch the line near Dawlish as a possession is planned for the night.
- **TaD - Rush Hour Coast Run**
Drive Train 2E40 from Paignton to Exeter, but keep a close eye on the line as you follow the late running Train 2F17.
- **TaD - Deltic down the sea**
Drive Train 1Z55 from Exeter to Paignton fitting in around the morning trains. Then you shall be returning to Exeter light engine as 5Z55.
- **TaD - CrossCountry along the Coast**
Starting 30 minutes late, drive Train 5M29 from Newton Abbot to Paignton in time to form Train 1M29 to Manchester Piccadilly, which you shall take as far as Exeter. It's ice Cold so be careful when speeding up and slowing down.
- **TaD - Race up the Coast**
Drive Train 2F45 from Paignton to Exeter on a clear summer afternoon, but will everything go according to plan?
- **TaD - Doubled Up**
Shunt together two Class 150 DMU Units to form Train 2T08 to Paignton. Can you prepare the train in time for your scheduled departure off Exeter?
- **TaD – Steam up the Sea**
Drive Train 5Z45 from Newton Abbot to Paignton where you pick up the railtour to London Paddington, which you shall take as far as Exeter.
- **TaD - Coast to Capital**
Drive Train 1A87 from Paignton to Exeter on a foggy afternoon.
- **TaD - Summer Heat**
It's a scorching hot summer's day on the Riviera Line and you're taking Train 1V47 from Exeter to Paignton. There have been a few reports of train failures due to overheating components this week due to the weather, so watch out when using the brakes.
